5km handicap June 2024

They say it's always better to have something to live up to, rather than live down and Rob Gilham did just that. Having won the "Most improved" category at the 2024 Quaker awards he ran his fastest parkrun for 10 years. He threatened to break the 21 minute barrier for most of last year but this month he went and smashed it with a 20:36 and takes a very deserved, 1st place. Louise Trainor, who has exactly the same fastest time as Rob at Darlington parkrun, added another level to the superlative performance that she achieved last month and moves up from having the eighth highest age grading by a Quaker at Darlington parkrun to sixth on the list. By my calculations she only needs another nine seconds to move ahead of Dean Newton into fifth. Continuing the theme of best performance for ages, Jo Meynell ran her fastest parkrun for five years to take third.

Uniquely, none of the top three performances was a PB, but the next five made up for that. John Yeomans and Carys Samuel had exactly the same score, down to four decimal places. I'm listing them in that order because John would have shaded it if it had been to five decimal places, but it wasn't, so they share fourth place. Rachel Grayson, Carmelita Coco and Helen Clark also set PB's with Carmelita's moving her into the 70% age grading category for the first time. Someone else who broke into the 70% age grading category at Darlington for the first time this month was Gill Colling, who ran her fastest time for five years. (Unfortunately Gill elected to run at Sedgefield in the 5km handicap this year, so it didn't count).

We have to go all the way down to ninth place before we have someone not beating their best ever age grading but Tracey Fleming so very nearly did, being just two seconds short. Incidentally I have Dave Thompson to thank for enabling me to calculate how much faster people need to run to achieve a particular age grading. Dave ran Sedgefield twice this month with the two runs being just one second apart and that equated to 0.05 in terms of age grading. That figure will vary slightly depending on what your baseline age grading was and, I dare say, on your age and gender as well but probably not by enough to make any significant difference.

Using the same reasoning, Rob Dent was only nine seconds off beating his best ever age grading for tenth. Lisa Bowerbank and Ian Burgess shared 11th place, again listed in the order they would have come had we gone down to five decimal places. Helen Clarke was also within 1% of her best ever age grading for 13th place in what was possibly the second most competitive round ever (I couldn't be bother to check every round, ever, so you'll just have to play along with me on that one).

I'm going to get my corrections to the overall scores out of the way at the start this time. Chris Land had his best ever round last month in ninth place but ironically it turns out that he was no longer a member. I have gone back and amended the scores for April and May, so quite a few people moved up a couple of points, though I think only a couple changed places as a result. Also for some reason that I can't begin to imagine, I had given Andy Walker a ridiculously unfeasible low score (unfeasible unless there 90 odd people taking part and he came last, that is). Needless to say, Andy shot up several places. If anyone else notices something wrong with the tables, please do shout up; every point matters in this competition.

Anyway, on to the competition itself. Due to a few injury niggles, Chris Clark wasn't able to get a run in this month, which shook things up quite a bit. Carys Samuel and Carmelita Coco simply moved up a place to be in first and second respectively (not that there is ever anything simple about setting a

new PB). Despite only managing 14th place this month, Malcolm Hewitson moved up two places to third as most of the people ahead of him were further down the overall table in May. Emily Beaumont manages to hang onto fourth but now has to share it with Jo Meynell who moved up three places. Stuart Masterman will almost certainly be looking to drop this round at the end of the year but still managed to hang on to sixth, though Helen Clark managed to close 12 points on him this month and is now just behind him in seventh. Unsurprisingly, Rob Gillham continued his recent surge up the table into eighth and Lisa Bowerbank snook up another place to ninth. Such have been his dominant performances in earlier rounds that Chris Clark still manages to hang on to tenth place but only one place ahead of Ian Burgess. Along with Tracey Fleming, Ian had the distinction of being the biggest improver this month (a rectified Andy Walker notwithstanding), moving up five places, while John Yeomans and Rachel Grayson unsurprisingly move up four apiece.

So that is June out of the way and as I say every year, we're only half way and anything can happen. It does strike me though that it really doesn't seem a year since I said it. Time is definitely not a constant as you get older. Carpe diem everyone (or whatever the running equivalent is).
