## 5km handicap results - February 2025

As you'll know by now, I love it when new people get in the mix for a place in the top ten of this competition. So I was delighted to see David Ledgerwood featuring not just in the top ten but at the top of the top ten. David is our most northerly participant so far in the competition's history as he is taking part at Prudhoe Riverside this year, which from the photos on their website looks well worth a bit of parkrun tourism. It even has a café, so presumably toilets (That is the emoji for an ageing prostate, right?)

In second place, Emily Beaumont was the only person to set a PB this month, her second in two months. In fact this wasn't just a PB at Sedgefield, which is a somewhat slow course, but a lifetime PB at any parkrun, her previous best being at the faster course of Tees Barrage when she was five years younger. All of which is of course totally unremarkable and quite to be expected, so moving swiftly on, in third place Andrew Vernon was the only other person to improve on his age grading. Wisely Andrew only improved it by a mere fraction, as these new best age grades will become their handicaps for March.

Paige Robson is brand new to the competition, with this February being her first ever round and she managed to go straight in at fourth place, just one ten-thousandth ahead of Dave Jones. Dave is taking part at Wynyard this year and was the first place finisher this month. Now as we all know, parkrun isn't a race so I would just like to stress that this definitely wasn't a race as the next person home was two minutes behind him. Andy Walker improved slightly on his time from last month and appropriately improved slightly on his position, up from seventh to sixth. I had expectations that Andy might win this competition a few years ago, and I think I might just have again (no pressure Andy ©).

In seventh place, not quite a new person to the top ten, I think I've managed it in two other months over the years, but one of those was with a soft handicap at Sedgefield. This month I earned it by the sweat of my brow and the DOMS in my legs and will be trying my best to do it again. Someone who was new however was Diane Vaughan. Only two people in the entire 250ish members of Quakers, not just those taking part in this competition, have a higher recent age grading than Diane. This means she has given herself a mountain to climb, but climb it she is, as she managed eighth place this month.

Of course I also love it when the regulars show that the can still get into the top ten, despite the increasingly difficult handicaps that they get year on year and who else to round off the top ten then but Jo Meynell and Lisa Bowerbank.

In the competition as a whole, with two months gone Emily has a two point lead over Andrew Vernon, with Dave Jones' two fifth places leaving him in third. Only alphabetical order separates Andy Walker and Lisa Bowerbank, who share fourth place. In sixth place is James Atkinson, another new participant. James could only manage eleventh this month but his fourth place from January shows that he has what it takes to threaten the podium later in the year.

I think it would be fair to say that Jan Waite and Rob Dent are very different athletes and have a very different approach to their participation in the competition but what they do have in common is 180 points and seventh place. This leaves the ever present and ever consistent, Stuart Masterman on his

own, in ninth. Unusually, there are thirteen people in the top ten this month; not because the laws of the Universe have somehow been rescinded (that will have to wait until Donald Trump's next speech) but just that David Nalder, Helen Clarke and Jo Meynell are all on 173 points.
