## 5km handicap – June 2025 results

It was the hottest June on record, which is maybe why the June round of the competition wasn't. No-one set a PB and only two people beat their baseline. Unsurprisingly, one of them was Andrew Vernon, who was 45 seconds down on his time for May but still had enough for a clear first place. I missed it at the time, but Andrew's age grading of 78.15% last month moves him up to 14<sup>th</sup> on the Quakers all-time age grading at Darlington (and thereby moving Ian Burgess back down to 15<sup>th</sup>). Surprisingly, the other one was Lisa Bowerbank. Lisa is supposed to knock out a 24:20 each month (give or take three seconds) not go throwing in a sub 24 for only the second time in the 280 times that she's run Darlington parkrun.

Despite his aversion to running in hot weather, Andy Walker managed third, just getting the better of his main rival, Dave Jones. Dave Thompson had what I am sure is his best ever performance in the competition for fifth. Had he not missed the first round he would easily be in the top ten overall now, so may well be in the mix come the end of the year.

When I said that this round wasn't hot, that does do a considerable disservice to the next three, with each of Diane Vaughan, Dawn Richardson and Marc Ellis all going comfortably above the 80% age grading. Diane in sixth had the lowest of the three age grades with what was still a pretty fabulous 81.53 and bear in mind that, other than those three, only three other Quakers have ever beat the age grading that Diane set this month (and one of those was only by four, 100ths). I had just written that I think it's a good bet to say that having three Quakers go over 80% at Darlington parkrun in one month has never happened before and not just in this competition. Then I thought I'd better do a bit of research and it turns out that the three of them did it in the competition last month as well. So, other than last month, I think it's a good bet to say that this has never happened before.

Meanwhile a little more towards the tortoise end (that's not an insult, we all know how that ended) Sally Singleton continues to plod on relentlessly with her fourth top ten place in a row. Bringing up the top ten is James Atkinson. I think James is this year's dark horse, so much so that one month I initially forgot to give him any points (Sorry, James – I get there in the end). James just to say made it into the top ten though, with the equivalent of less than a second preventing Anthony Corbett from the singular experience of getting a mention two months in a row.

In the overall competition, Andrew Vernon now leads by 11 points. Of the three people who shared second in May, Andy Walker just to say pulls ahead for Dave Jones to have second all to himself, while Emily Beaumont, who finished outside of the top ten for the first time this year drops down to fifth. Taking advantage of Emily taking her foot of the gas, Lisa Bowerbank gained a massive 18 points to move her up to fourth, though she will need something similar to move up into the top three. Sally, who has gradually been reeling in Jan Waite, such that they were level in May, now takes a three point lead for sixth. James Atkinson and Ian Hart stay in their respective positions of eighth and ninth though with a slightly tighter grip, but Helen Clark not having been able to get a run in this month opened the door for me to move up a place to tenth. While I've had the odd top ten placing in individual months, I think this is the first time that I have ever been in the top ten in the overall competition. Of the 22 people who have done all six rounds, Julie Bell was the biggest improver up five places to 13<sup>th</sup>. She'd better not get any ideas though; I'm not giving up tenth without a fight.
